SERMON NOTES

“Wondering After the Beast”

- I. “Water” verse 1 = Peoples, multitudes, nations and tongues (Revelation 17:15).
- II. “The four beasts” of Daniel 7:3 and the composite beast of Revelation 13:2.
 1. “Mouth of a lion” verse 2 = Babylon (Daniel 7:3,4).
 2. “Feet of a bear” verse 2 = Medo-Persia (Daniel 7:5).
 3. “Like unto a leopard” = Greece (Daniel 7:6).
- III. “Having seven heads” verse 1.
 1. “The seven heads are seven mountains...and these are seven kings” Revelation 17:9,10.
 2. “Five are fallen” Revelation 17:10
 - A. Egypt, Assyria, Babylon, Medo-Persia, and Greece.
 3. “One is” Pagan Rome (at the time of John).
 4. “The other is not yet come” Papal Rome
 5. “Upon his heads the name or names of blasphemy, verse 1.
- IV. The latest head becomes the dominant power of the beast verse 3.
 1. “One of his heads wounded to death” 1798 and 1870
 2. “And his deadly wound was healed” February 11, 1929 Lateran Treaty
- V. “And the dragon” verse 2 = Pagan Rome Revelation 12:4 and Satan Revelation 12:9.
 1. “Gave him his power” verse 2 = Clovis in 508 AD gave an army to the Bishop of Rome.
 2. “Gave him his seat” verse 2 = Constantine in 330 AD gave the Bishop of Rome the city of Rome; he moved to Constantinople.
 3. “Gave him his great authority” verse 2 = Political and Religious authority.
- VI. “And all the world wondered after the beast” verse 3. How could this happen?
 1. Blessing when we follow the will of God that is revealed to us. Matthew 16:15-17.
 2. Tragedy when we follow our own will and ignore what has been revealed to us. Matthew 16:21-23.
