NOTE FROM NEPAL

Dear Friends,

We have been in Nepal for almost a week. If prayer is needed in the US-it is needed even more here.

The political situation is calm here. We are in no danger of mobs. All the trouble seems to be in the areas close to the Indian border.

I preached the "Kept" sermon twice last Sabbath. Once to the Nepali church and once to the English church here at the SDA hospital in Banepa. Whenever I preach the Bible theory of the sermon, the Lord always gives me the spiritual lab later that challenges me.

So Sunday both Elizabeth and I came down with G.I. problems. Elizabeth already has a cold and a running nose. We trusted someone who told us that the water was boiled. So health is a prayer request.

The visa issue is complex. If we get it thru the hospital-they still are under a ban to not preach. So we are leaning on the Lord for guidance.

On the blessing side: The ADRA Director for Nepal is moving from his house in Kathmandu to a place closer to the ADRA headquarters the end of February. We looked at it yesterday and it is wonderful. We wish it was a little larger (only 2 BR). But it was lots of windows for light and sun, is centrally located to all the places in the Kathmandu Valley.

We are told that only the work that is mixed with prayer and Bible study will in the end prove to be effective. We pray that your prayers for us and ours for you will be used by God to accomplish his will.
