 "Last Days Deceptions"

SEVENTH-DAY ADVENTISTS BELIEVE:

“Last Day Deceptions & How to Avoid Being Deceived”

I. Trust in God and not in money.

1. Beware of the deceitfulness of riches.
Matthew 13:22
2. The love of money can seduce us away from the faith. **1 Timothy 6:6-11**

II. Use the Bible to determine truth.

1. While others are turning to spirits for direction, only the Bible has the truth.
Isaiah 8:19&20
2. The doctrines of devils shall cause some to depart from the faith. **1 Timothy 4:1&2**

“Many will be confronted by the spirits of devils personating beloved relatives or friends and declaring the most dangerous heresies. These visitants will appeal to our tenderest sympathies and will work miracles to sustain their pretensions.” *The Great Controversy, page 560*

3. Some people will not endure sound doctrine and will turn away from truth.
2 Timothy 4:2&3

“That time has fully come. The multitudes do not want Bible truth because it interferes with the desires of the sinful, world-loving heart; and Satan supplies the deceptions which they love.”
The Great Controversy, page 595

III. Follow the leading of the Holy Spirit.

1. Allow the Holy Spirit to guide you into all truth. **John 16:13&14**
2. While seeking to be guided by the Holy Spirit, we should be careful not to look within ourselves for truth. Truth lies outside of us in God’s Word. **John 17:17**
3. When the Holy Spirit reproves or convicts, respond positively. This shows that you love the truth. **John 16:7&8**
4. Those who do not love the truth will be deceived. **2 Thessalonians 2:9-12**
5. Recognize the value of the Spirit of Prophecy.
Ephesians 4:11-15

IV. Do not believe what you see but what you know from God’s Word.

1. Don’t be deceived by false christs.
Matthew 24:4&5
2. Don’t be deceived by great signs and wonders.
Matthew 24:23-27
