## SERMON NOTES

### **“What Is Our Destiny?”**

Definitions: Destiny—“The inevitable or necessary succession of events.” Predestine: “To determine or decree beforehand.” Webster’s New World Dictionary.

Our Destiny is:

- I. To be saved.
  1. We have been chosen by God to be His children—Ephesians 1:4,5.
  2. It is God’s will that we be saved—I Timothy 2:4.

*“The sinner may resist this love, may refuse to be drawn to Christ; but if he does not resist he will be drawn to Jesus; a knowledge of the plan of salvation will lead him to the foot of the cross in repentance for his sins, which have caused the sufferings of God’s dear Son.” Steps to Christ page 27*

- II. To be aliens and strangers.
  1. We don’t belong here—we are citizens of heaven—Philippians 3:17-21.
  2. Our longing for our homeland—Hebrews 11:8-10, 13-16, 39,40.
- III. To do the work that has been prepared for us.
  1. God has great plans for us—Jeremiah 29:11-13.
  2. We were created for good works—Ephesians 2:8-10.
  3. Esther—“This is your destiny”—Esther 4:12-14.
- IV. To be witnesses
  1. We are to be witnesses—Acts 1:8.
  2. To be witnesses of what we have seen and heard—Acts 22:15.

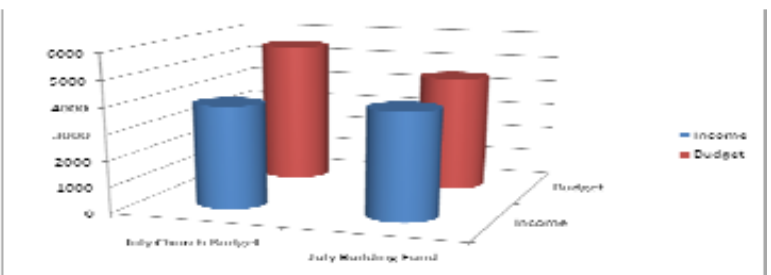
