"The Downs & Ups of a Happy Family"

Which is better?

Ups and downs — Proverbs 16:18

Downs and ups — 1 Peter 5:6

The destroyers of the happy family are <u>anger, strife and pride.</u> Proverbs 29:22,23.

"Actually, anger is a secondary emotion, not a primary feeling. It arises out of hurt, frustration, fear, or some combination of all three." <u>Making Love Last Forever</u>, by Gary Smalley, page 20.

A. Joseph

- 1. Hurt when his brothers sold him into slavery. Genesis 37:23-28.
- 2. Hurt when Potiphar took his wife's word over Joseph's. Genesis 39:7-20.
- Hurt when the Butler forgot to mention him to Pharaoh. Genesis 40:9-15,23. Joseph refused to let his "hurt" make him angry. How do we know? Because God gave him grace.
- 4. Slavery—grace in Potiphar's house. Genesis 39:1-6.
- 5. Thrown in jail—grace with warden. Genesis 39:21-23.
- 6. Forgotten by Butler—grace with Pharaoh. Genesis 41:37-45.

Why did God give Joseph grace? Because Joseph was humble. 1 Peter 5:5.

B. Job

- Frustrated over the loss of wealth, children and health. Job 1:13-28.
- 2. Frustrated with his wife. Job 2:9.
- 3. Frustrated with his friends. Job 2:11 to Job 37:24.

Job refused to let his "frustration" make him angry. How do we know? Because after Job humbled himself and prayed for his friends, God exalted him. Job 42:10 and 1 Peter 5:6.
