SERMON NOTES"Our Destiny"

- What we had.
 - 1. We were made in God's image and likeness. Genesis 1:26,27.
 - 2. We had dominion over all the earth. Genesis 1:26, 28.
 - 3. We had the ability to replenish or create life. Genesis 1:28.
 - 4. We were made a little lower than God and we were given dominion over all that God had made. Psalms 8:3-6, I Corinthians 6:2.3.
- II. What we lost.
 - 1. We are under a death penalty, Genesis 2:17, and have lost eternal life. Genesis 3:22.
 - 2. We have lost our dominion over the things in the earth—now we are under the dominion of sin. Romans 6:14.
- III. How we regain what we lost.
 - 1. The accuser has to be satisfied. Revelation 12:9.10.
 - 2. Our "death penalty" must be legally cared for. Hebrews 2:5-11.
 - 3. The dominion must be taken away from the one who "stole" it. Psalms 110:1,2.
 - 4. The restoration process as seen in Daniel 7 Verses1-8. Daniel beholds the 4 beasts and horns. Verses 9-10 The judgment is set—the books are open. Verses 11,12 Beasts slain—their dominion taken away. Verse 13 Jesus comes to the Father

Verse 14 Dominion is given to Jesus.

Verses 15,16 Daniel is upset—wants answers

Verses 17,18 Short answer—the saints shall take and possess the kingdom.

Verses 19,20 Daniel wants more information on the 4th beast and little horn.

Verses 21,22 The little horn makes war and prevails against the saints until the coming of the Ancient of Days and judgment is given in favor of the saints and they possess the kingdom. Christ's death on the cross removed the threat of the death penalty and all who accept this pardon become members of His kingdom.

Verses 23-25 The little horn described

Verses 26-28 Judgment sits and dominion is taken from the little horn and given back to us. Daniel still does not get it.
