SEVENTH-DAY ADVENTISTS BELIEVE:

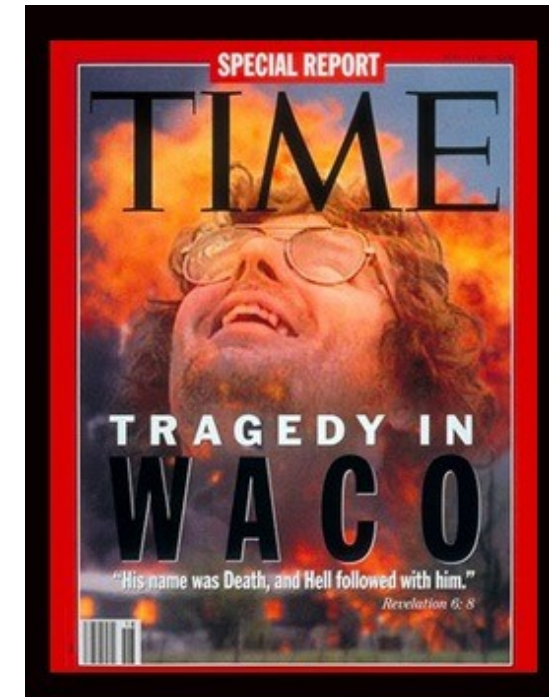
