

Six Truths of Communion

Creation, Incarnation, Atonement, Resurrection, Exaltation, Eschatology John 1:1, 3, 4, 14; 2 Corinthians 5:21; Hebrews 4:14-16; Philippians 2:9-11

1. Leader:

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

2. All:

All things were made by Him; and without Him was not anything made that was made.

3. Leader:

In Him was life; and the life was the light of men.

4. All:

And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

5. Leader:

For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

6. Women:

Seeing then that we have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our profession.

7. Men:

For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin.

8. All:

Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace that we might obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

9. Leader:

God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name; that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth;

10. All:

And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

11. Leader:

And behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be.
